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The Background and History

How Could Something That Seemed So Good Turn Out So Badly?

- Now the sons of Eli were sons of Belial; they knew not YHWH...
- Wherefore the sin of the young men was very great before YHWH: for men abhorred the offering of YHWH. (I Samuel 2:12, 17)
 - How could this situation be?
 - These men were great-grandsons of Aaron
 - What were they doing that was so bad???

- And the priests' custom with the people was, that, when any man offered sacrifice, the priest's servant came, while the flesh was in seething, with a fleshhook of three teeth in his hand;
- And he struck it into the pan, or kettle, or caldron, or pot; all that the fleshhook brought up the priest took for himself. So they did in Shiloh unto all the Israelites that came thither. Also before they burnt the fat, the priest's servant came, and said to the man that sacrificed,
- Give flesh to roast for the priest; for he will not have sodden flesh of thee, but raw.
- And if any man said unto him, Let them not fail to burn the fat presently, and then take as much as thy soul desireth; then he would answer him, Nay; but thou shalt give it me now: and if not, I will take it by force. (I Samuel 2:13-13)

- •What happened to Eli's sons?
- •Did they ever suffer for their sins?

The Obscure Prophecy

- And there came a man of Elohim unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith YHWH, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?
- And did I choose him out of all the tribes of Israel to be my priest, to offer upon mine altar, to burn incense, to wear an ephod before me? and did I give unto the house of thy father all the offerings made by fire of the children of Israel?
- Wherefore kick ye at my sacrifice and at mine offering, which I have commanded in my habitation; and honorest thy sons above me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel my people? (I Samuel 2:27-29)

The Obscure Prophecy

- Wherefore YHWH Elohim of Israel saith, I said indeed that thy house, and the house of thy father, should walk before me for ever: but now YHWH saith, Be it far from me; for them that honor me I will honor, and they that despise me shall be lightly esteemed.
- Behold, the days come, that I will cut off thine arm, and the arm of thy father's house, that there shall not be an old man in thine house.
- And thou shalt see an enemy in my habitation, in all the wealth which Elohim shall give Israel: and there shall not be an old man in thine house for ever. (I Samuel 2:30-32)

The Obscure Prophecy

- And the man of thine, whom I shall not cut off from mine altar, shall be to consume thine eyes, and to grieve thine heart: and all the increase of thine house shall die in the flower of their age.
- And this shall be a sign unto thee, that shall come upon thy two sons, on Hophni and Phinehas; in one day they shall die both of them.
- And I will raise me up a faithful priest, that shall do according to that which is in mine heart and in my mind: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before mine anointed for ever. (I Samuel 2:33-35)

- And the word of Samuel came to all Israel. Now Israel went out against the Philistines to battle, and pitched beside Ebenezer: and the Philistines pitched in Aphek.
- And the Philistines put themselves in array against Israel: and when they joined battle, Israel was smitten before the Philistines: and they slew of the army in the field about four thousand men. (I Samuel 4:1-2)
 - When Samuel's word went out to Israel, did they consult their Heavenly Father about how or where to engage in battle?
 - Did they pray about what strategies and tactics they should use?

- And when the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore hath YHWH smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of YHWH out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our enemies. (I Samuel 4:3)
 - This will have to rank as the most bone-headed moves Israel would ever make.
 - Where in the Torah does it say you can take the Ark of the Covenant into battle?

- So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from thence the ark of the covenant of YHWH of hosts, which dwelleth between the cherubims: and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were there with the ark of the covenant of Elohim.
- And when the ark of the covenant of YHWH came into the camp, all Israel shouted with a great shout, so that the earth rang again. (I Samuel 4:5-5)
 - The Israelites were excited about having the Ark of the Covenant come to their battleground.
 - However, excitement does not win battles. Good strategy and tactics wins battles!

- And when the Philistines heard the noise of the shout, they said, What meaneth the noise
 of this great shout in the camp of the Hebrews? And they understood that the ark of
 YHWH was come into the camp.
- And the Philistines were afraid, for they said, Elohim is come into the camp. And they said, Woe unto us! for there hath not been such a thing heretofore.
- Woe unto us! who shall deliver us out of the hand of these mighty Elohims? these are the Elohims that smote the Egyptians with all the plagues in the wilderness. (I Samuel 4:6-8)
 - The Philistines were concerned about the Ark of the Covenant as well.
 - However, from their statements, we learn they did not know anything about YHWH.

- Be strong, and quit yourselves like men, O ye Philistines, that ye be not servants unto the Hebrews, as they have been to you: quit yourselves like men, and fight.
- And the Philistines fought, and Israel was smitten, and they fled every man into his tent: and there was a very great slaughter; for there fell of Israel thirty thousand footmen.
- And the ark of Elohim was taken; and the two sons of Eli: Hophni and Phinehas,
 were slain. (I Samuel 4:9-II)

- And the man said unto Eli, I am he that came out of the army, and I fled to day out of the army. And he said, What is there done, my son?
- And the messenger answered and said, Israel is fled before the Philistines, and there hath been also a great slaughter among the people, and thy two sons also, Hophni and Phinehas, are dead, and the ark of Elohim is taken.
- And it came to pass, when he made mention of the ark of Elohim, that he fell from off the seat backward by the side of the gate, and his neck brake, and he died: for he was an old man, and heavy. And he had judged Israel forty years. (1 Samuel 4:16-18)

- And Samuel spake unto all the house of Israel, saying, If ye do return unto YHWH with all your hearts, then put away the strange elohim and Ashtaroth from among you, and prepare your hearts unto YHWH, and serve him only: and he will deliver you out of the hand of the Philistines.
- Then the children of Israel did put away Baalim and Ashtaroth, and served YHWH only. And Samuel said, Gather all Israel to Mizpeh, and I will pray for you unto YHWH.
- And they gathered together to Mizpeh, and drew water, and poured it out before YHWH, and fasted on that day, and said there, We have sinned against YHWH. And Samuel judged the children of Israel in Mizpeh. (I Samuel 7:3-6)

- And when the Philistines heard that the children of Israel were gathered together to Mizpeh, the rulers of the Philistines went up against Israel. And when the children of Israel heard it, they were afraid of the Philistines.
- And the children of Israel said to Samuel, Cease not to cry unto YHWH our Elohim for us, that he will save us out of the hand of the Philistines.
- And Samuel took a sucking lamb, and offered it for a burnt offering wholly unto YHWH: and Samuel cried unto YHWH for Israel; and YHWH heard him. (1 Samuel 7:7-9)

- And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but YHWH thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and discomfited them; and they were smitten before Israel.
- And the men of Israel went out of Mizpeh, and pursued the Philistines, and smote them, until they came under Beth-car.
- Then Samuel took a stone, and set it between Mizpeh and Shen, and called the name of it Ebenezer, saying, Hitherto hath YHWH helped us. (1 Samuel 7:10-12)

- So the Philistines were subdued, and they came no more into the coast of Israel: and the hand of YHWH was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel.
- And the cities which the Philistines had taken from Israel were restored to Israel, from Ekron even unto Gath; and the coasts thereof did Israel deliver out of the hands of the Philistines. And there was peace between Israel and the Amorites.
- And Samuel judged Israel all the days of his life. (1 Samuel 7:13-15)

Again, a Good Organization Turn Bad?

- And it came to pass, when Samuel was old, that he made his sons judges over Israel.
- Now the name of his firstborn was Joel; and the name of his second, Abiah: they were judges in Beer-sheba.
- And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment.

(I Samuel 8: I-3)

Sons Do Not Follow the Ways of Their Father

- While Samuel is considered one of Israel's greatest prophets, his sons were not so reputed. They lacked these things:
 - I. They did not walk in the ways of their father.
 - 2. They sought unjust gain using their position as Judges over Israel.
 - 3. They took bribes and perverted judgment!

Thou shalt not wrest judgment; thou shalt not respect persons, neither take a gift: for a gift doth blind the eyes of the wise, and pervert the words of the righteous.

(Deuteronomy 16:19)

A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.

(Proverbs 17:23)

The Trap of Money

- No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve YHWH and <u>mammon</u>. (Luke 16:13)
- For the <u>love of money</u> is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. (I Timothy 6:10)

- 2. An elder then must be blameless, the man of one woman, vigilant, sober, of good behavior, given to hospitality, apt to teach;
- 3. Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous;
- 4. One that rules well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity;
- 5. (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the "called out" assembly of Elohiym?)
- 6. Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. (I Timothy 3:2-6)

- Likewise must the deacons be grave, not doubletongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre;
- Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.
- And let these also first be proved; then let them use the office of a deacon, being found blameless.
- Even so must their women be grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all things.
- Let the deacons be the men of one woman, ruling their children and their own houses well.
- For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Mashiach Yahusha. (I Timothy 3:8-13)

- 7. For an elder must be blameless, as the steward of Elohiym; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre;
- 8. But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate;
- 9. Holding fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.
- 10. For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision:
- 11. Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake. (Titus 1:7-11)

- I. THE elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of *Mashiach*, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed:
- 2. Feed the flock of *Elohiym* which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;
- 3. Neither as being adoniym over Elohiym's heritage, but being examples to the flock. (I Peter 5:1-3)

Marks of Evil Leadership

- 15. Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;
- 16.But was rebuked for his <u>iniquity</u>: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet. (II Peter 2:15-16)
 - Iniquity = Committing a sin despite knowing what you are doing is wrong!

Marks of Evil Leadership

- 11. Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core (Korah). (Jude 11)
 - Way of Cain (Character Assassination)
 - Error of Balaam (Peddling Your Spiritual Knowledge for Money)
 - Gainsaying of Korah (Usurping Legitimate Spiritual Authority)

THE RESTORATION OF FAITH

- When the apostles died off at the end of the first century, the church "fathers" started to degenerate the faith. Some of them adopted Greek philosophy while others fell into other false doctrines. Undoubtedly, money became an issue as well.
- Through history, we saw revivals of the Christian faith and the recovery of specific doctrines.
 - Peter Waldo (Waldensians) The Bible could be translated into the local language and studied in that language. (14th century)
 - Martin Luther The Just shall live by faith. You cannot earn your salvation. (16th century)
 - John Wesley You serve the Messiah by Obedience (Holiness). (18th + 19th centuries)
 - Pentecostalism The mass restoration of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. (early 20th century)
 - Deliverance The mass restoration of Casting Out Evil Spirits. (1960+)

THE RESTORATION OF FAITH

- In the United States, Christianity was enhanced by the following movements:
 - First Great Awakening Restoration of Holiness in Believers (1720-1800)
 - Second Great Awakening (1800-1880)
 - Holiness Movement (1880-1900)
 - Pentecostal Movement (1900-1965)
 - Charismatic Movement (1965-1980)
 - The Original Charismatic Movement brought people out of the Mainline Churches into the Full Gospel...
 - The use of mass-media to reach the masses...

THE RESTORATION OF FAITH

- The Evangelical (Baptist) Movements took exception to the Holiness, Pentecostal, and Charismatic Movements.
- With declining membership in the late 19th century, they found themselves beginning to adopt many of the precepts of the Holiness Movements while maintaining their own core beliefs.
- They continued to reject the moves of the Holy Spirit found in the Pentecostal and Charismatic movements.
- They instead choose to create large evangelistic meetings.
- They followed-up the evangelistic meetings by sending people to mega-churches designed to reinforce the evangelistic meetings.
- Even today, many tech companies have hired "evangelists" to sell their products.

How Did Matters Com e to this Pass?


- In the early part of the 20th century, some evangelists began to introduce the concept of "Soul-winning" in their evangelistic campaigns.
- The major players in this movement were:
 - Dr. J. Frank Norris (1877-1952)
 - Dr. John R. Rice (1895-1980)
 - Dr. Jack Hyles (1926-2001)
 - Dr. Billy Graham (1918-2018)

NOTE: All these men called themselves "doctor" based upon Honorary Degrees - no academic work involved!

The "Art of Soulwinning"

"...he that winneth souls is wise." Proverbs 11:30b

- The most successful member of the Soul-Winning Movement was Jack F. Hyles (1926-2001). He grew up in Italy, Texas, south of Dallas on I-35.
- He gained fame as the pastor of the First Baptist Church of Hammond, Indiana. He took over the church in 1959 when it had less than 1,000 members.
- When Dr. Hyles died in 2001, 20,000 people attended his church services every Sunday.
- First Baptist Church in Hammond, Indiana became the first real megachurch in the USA.
- Dr. Hyles was most famous for his bus ministry which had a multi-million-dollar annual budget. The story of First Baptist Church was written up in *Time* Magazine in the 1970s.






The "Art of Soulwinning"

- Jack Hyles' doctoral degree is an honorary degree from Hyles-Anderson Bible College, a non-accredited academic institution he helped start.
- Accusations of the church being cult-like, the child exploitation, and rumors of human trafficking stained the church's reputation in latter part of the 20th century.
- His son-in-law Rev. Jack Schaap, (who replaced him in the pulpit), was arrested for "Transporting a Minor in Interstate Commerce with Intent to Engage in Sexual Activity." He pleaded guilty and was sentenced to 12 years in federal custody.
 - I think Federal authorities had more evidence but hoped the problem would go away with Rev. Schaap's "plea bargain."




"...he that winneth souls is wise." Proverbs 11:30b



- Let's study the first key word in this verse:
 - "Winneth" is from the Hebrew word *laqach* (לקדו) used 975 times in the Old Testament.
- According to Brown, Driver, Briggs, the word means:
 - to take, get, fetch, lay hold of, seize, receive, acquire, buy, bring, marry, take a wife, snatch, take away
 - Laqach only gets translated "winneth" one time out of 975 occurrences in the Bible!

The "Art of Soulwinning"

".. he that winneth souls is wise." Proverbs 11:30b



- Let's study the second key word in this verse:
 - Wise is from the Hebrew word chakam (□□□) used 139 times in the Old Testament.
- According to Brown, Driver, Briggs, the word means:
 - Wise in terms of being "skillful, shrewd, crafty, cunning, wily, subtle."
 - Chakam gets translated "wise" most of the time in the KJV, but in our day and age, the word: "wise" holds a different meaning in the 21st century than it did in the 17th century.

The Real Translation:

...he that takes souls is cunning.

- Could this be possible?
- Could these preachers be stealing souls to enhance their own wealth?
- Why are we seeing a huge rise in megachurches, loaded with programs to keep the members busy and occupied?
- Why are their basic doctrines so shallow?









Did You Say Stealing Souls???

Here is what Ezekiel prophesied:

- I. Her priests have violated my Torah (law), and
- 2. have profaned mine holy things:
- 3. they have put no difference between the holy and profane,
- 4. neither have they shewed difference between the unclean and the clean, and
- 5. have hid their eyes from my Sabbaths, and
- 6. I am profaned among them (maybe not in word, but in deed). (Ezekiel 22:26)

Did You Say Stealing Souls???

- Here is what Ezekiel prophesied:
 - I. Her princes in the midst thereof are like wolves ravening the prey,
 - 2. to shed blood, and
 - 3. to destroy souls,
 - 4. to get dishonest gain.

(Ezekiel 22:27)

Did You Say Stealing Souls???

- Here is what Ezekiel Prophesied:
 - I. And her prophets have daubed them with untempered morter,
 - 2. seeing vanity, and
 - 3. divining lies unto them, saying,
 - 4. Thus saith the Master YHWH, when YHWH hath not spoken.

 (Ezekiel 22:28)

Here is what John Mark Prophesied:

- I. And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and
- 2. with the blood of the martyrs of Yahushua: and when I saw her,
- 3. I wondered with great "admiration." (Revelation 17:6)
- Why does the Harlot drink so much blood?
- Why was John Mark so amazed about the amount of blood she drank?

- But flesh with the life (soul) thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat. (Genesis 9:4)
- For the <u>life</u> (soul) of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the <u>soul</u>. (Leviticus 17:11)
- For it is the life (soul) of all flesh; the blood of it is for the life (blood) thereof: therefore I said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall eat the blood of no manner of flesh: for the life (soul) of all flesh is the blood thereof: whosoever eateth it shall be cut off. (Leviticus 17:14)

- •Only be sure that thou eat not the blood: for the blood is the life (soul); and thou mayest not eat the life (soul) with the flesh. (Deuteronomy 12:23)
- יללוקה. The horseleach (אלוקה) Alukah) hath two daughters, crying, Give, give. (Proverbs 30:15a)

- The horseleach (שלוקה Alukah) hath two daughters, crying, Give, give. (Proverbs 30:15a)
 - In Jewish lore (the Sefer Chasidim), the Alukah is a living human being that lives on blood (vampire), can shape-shift into a wolf (werewolf?), and when dead, must have its mouth filled with earth so it does not return as a demon.
 - Some scholars argue that Alukah is the name of a female demon that mothered Lilith (the "screech owl" of Isaiah 34:14). Lilith also had two daughters: one named Malia and the other named Lamia.
 - Other lore suggests that Lilith turns men into vampires.
- Occult and Masonic cults drink blood because they think it will extend their lives.
 - Alastair Crowley openly promoted the ideas that having sex with children and the drinking of their blood were the "elixirs of youth."
- It is apparent that what John Mark saw when he was given the Book of Revelation <u>was very literal</u>, not just symbolic and figurative.

Could the Devil Really Want You "Saved?"

- The Answer is **Yes** Under Certain Circumstances!
- Satan's Salvation Scenario
 - 1) Allow People to Get "Saved" in an Evangelistic Meeting.
 - Evangelistic Meetings are designed to create a certain amount of emotional fervor. This is done by the preacher using "soul power."
 - These evangelists project their "soul power" onto the attendees at the meeting.
 - The Preacher uses a combination using scriptures and emotions to create a soul tie between the preacher and the attendees.
 - The attendees, fraught with emotion, succumb to the pressure, and "get saved."

Could the DevilReally W ant You "Saved?"

- The Answer is <u>Yes</u> Under Certain Circumstances!
- Satan's Salvation Scenario
 - 2) Send the newly saved people to designated church organizations designed to deaden their spiritual growth:
 - Their "salvation experience" will be reinforced by the church's teachings.
 - They will become part of a group and develop a "oneness."
 - False Teachings like "a Christian cannot have a demon" and the mass of hyper-eternal security doctrines give people a false sense of security about their "faith."

COULD THE DEVIL REALLY WANT YOU "SAVED?"

- The Answer is Yes Under Certain Circumstances!
- Satan's Salvation Scenario
 - 2) Send the newly saved people to selected churches designed to deaden spiritual growth:
 - Dr. Rick Warren (The Purpose-Driven Church, etc.)
 believes that a church in of itself is a "collective
 soul."
 - He does not believe human beings have individual souls.

Could The DevilReally W ant You Saved?

- The Answer is Yes Under Certain Circumstances!
- Satan's Salvation Scenario
 - 3) In time, most of the people will be inserted into church programs designed to give them the illusion that they are "serving the LORD."
- Ask this question:
 - If our Heavenly Father were to withdraw the Holy Spirit from the earth, how would it affect your church?
 - Would their programs keep going?
 - Would the preacher just keep on doing sermons?
 - Would the church service proceed as usual?

It Gets Worse!

- 4) The "cream of the crop" of "Christians" are then designated to join various Masonic Lodges where they become "thrice born." (Jimmy Carter, reputed by the media for being "born again," he was once quoted in a *Time Magazine* Article as saying he was "thrice born.")
 - I. Born physically at birth.
 - 2. Born-again as a Christian.
 - 3. Reborn-again as a Mason. Starting at the 32nd level, they swear their allegiance to Lucifer the sorcerer of Isaiah 14:12-17.

There is no scripture that says Lucifer is the devil! That is Roman Catholic tradition and teaching. Please don't call a member of a Masonic Lodge a "devil-worshiper," normally they do not believe they are!

The "Thrice-born" Tradition

- Members of Masonic lodges often get preferential treatment in their jobs and in their business.
 - Many banks are more likely to loan money to their "brother Masons" than they are to anyone else.
 - When they commit crimes, the police either look the other way or they get off with a suspended sentence and a small fine.
 - Those with a nice spiritual bend are often financed to attend seminary and become pastors.
 - No wonder so many of our churches are dead! Their pastors are soldout Masons who have sold their souls to Hilel (wrongly called Lucifer).

Is Lucifer The Devil?

- How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! (Isaiah 14:12)
- They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, <u>Is this the man that made the earth to tremble</u>, that did shake kingdoms;
- That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners? (Isaiah 14:16-17)
 - It is clear, Lucifer is nothing but a sorcerer!
 - The Hebrew word is הֵילֵל (Hilel). The Name "Lucifer" did not appear in a Bible until A.D. 700 when a Bible was produced for Charlamagne when he was crowned Holy Roman Emperor. Charlamagne was illerate!

Bodies, Souls, and Commodities

- When Church Organizations Capture Bodies and Souls:
 - Bodies and Souls can be separated and sold separately on commodity exchanges around the world.
 - You will not see them listed on any official commodity exchange because bodies and souls are only traded in the occult world.
 - Once someone controls a soul, they have the ability to use the person's mind, will, and emotions for their own personal gain.

Can Souls be Divided?

- Consider the Following Scriptures:
 - Lest he <u>tear my soul like a lion, rending it in pieces</u>, while there is none to deliver. (Psalms 7:2)
 - Now consider this, ye that forget Eloah, lest I tear you in pieces, and there be none to deliver. (Psalms 50:22)

Bodies, Souls and Commodities

• In Practice, souls are fragmented before they are sold.

- The cost of an individual soul is very high.
- Most buyers are only interested in the parts of the soul that will benefit them the most in their business endeavors.

Examples:

- A company may only want the part of your soul that will cause you to choose their product over their competitors even if the competitor's product is better.
- A corrupted church organization will only want the part of your soul that will cause you to attend their services, participate in their programs, and part with your money.

Is There Any Hope?

- Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. (Matthew 11:29)
- Yahushua said unto him, Thou shalt love YHWH thy Elohim with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. (Matthew 22:37-38, Mark 12:30, and Luke 10:27, quoting Deuteronomy 6:5)

It is Important to Seek YHW H?

- But if from thence thou shalt seek YHWH thy Elohim, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul. When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to YHWH thy Elohim, and shalt be obedient unto his voice; (For YHWH thy Elohim is a merciful El;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them. (Deuteronomy 4:29-31)
- And now, Israel, what doth YHWH thy Elohim require of thee, but to fear YHWH thy
 Elohim, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve YHWH thy Elohim with all
 thy heart and with all thy soul, To keep the commandments of YHWH, and his statutes,
 which I command thee this day for thy good? (Deuteronomy 10:12-13)

It is Important to Seek YHW H?

- And shalt return unto YHWH thy Elohim, and shalt obey his voice according to all that I command thee this day, thou and thy children, with all thine heart, and with all thy soul; That then YHWH thy Elohim will turn thy captivity, and have compassion upon thee, and will return and gather thee from all the nations, whither YHWH thy Elohim hath scattered thee. (Deuteronomy 30:2-3)
- And YHWH thy Elohim will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love YHWH thy Elohim with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live. (Deuteronomy 30:6)

How Many Times Have You Read the 23rd Psalm?

- I. YHWH is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- 2. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.
- 3. He <u>restoreth my soul</u>: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
- 4. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.
- 5. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.
- 6. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of YHWH for ever. (Psalms 23:1-6)

SoulRestoration Scriptures

- The Spirit of the Master YHWH is upon me; because YHWH hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;
